

RESOLUTION NO. R-11-26

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
AFFIRMING SUPPORT FOR THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
MARYLAND, AND VIRGINIA (DMV) MOVES PLAN

WHEREAS, in May 2024, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG) and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) adopted a resolution establishing the DMV Moves Task Force to produce a consensus-based vision, plan, funding model, and action steps to deliver world-class transit for the District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia (DMV) region, and also established a Community Partners Advisory Group and Government Partners Advisory Group to support the Task Force; and

WHEREAS, with guidance from the Task Force, staff from MWCOG and WMATA identified the funding needs for both WMATA and the region's local transit providers to support existing operations and modernize their systems; and

WHEREAS, the plan recommends establishing a dedicated annual capital commitment for WMATA that increases annually by three percent to support Metro's long-term modernization and advance actions to better integrate and strengthen coordination among the region's fourteen transit operators, including Metro, MARC, VRE, and local bus systems; and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2025, MWCOG and WMATA adopted a resolution endorsing the DMV Moves Plan as developed by the DMV Moves Task Force and urging the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) at MWCOG to serve as the lead coordinator for implementation of the plan, including convening stakeholders, monitoring progress, and issuing progress reports; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gaithersburg recognizes the need for a comprehensive and coordinated regional effort to address long-term transit needs and the longstanding systemic funding challenges facing Metro and the region's other transit systems and supports the mission and recommendations of the DMV Moves Task Force:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of Gaithersburg, that the City supports MWCOG's DMV Moves initiative and endorses the recommendations set forth in the DMV Moves Plan as developed by the DMV Moves Task Force.
